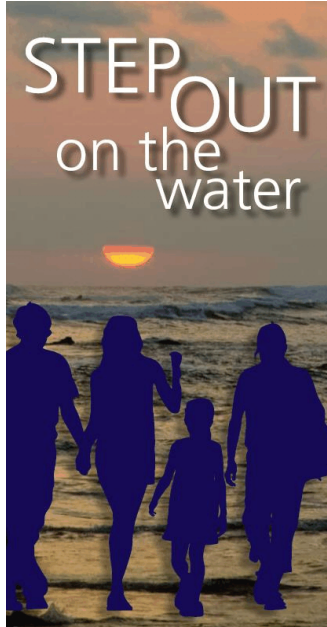
Market Square
